### **8<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> Grade Students: Servant Life Trip to Philadelphia**

**Dates:** July 30 - August 3

**What will the team be doing?** This is a week-long service trip put on by Servant Life. The students stay at Eastern University.
