We require that the children memorize and recite all the verses and their references in order to get credit towards the reward nights in the fall and spring. We have dates built in to make up missed verses. The verses are taken from the Hands On Bible (NLT translation).

Verses can be made up at any time during the fall, but these verses cannot be made up after December 5.

The children also earn Club Cash for reciting their verses to spend on Snack/Store/ Game Night. Here are ways for them to earn **extra Club Cash** in addition to reciting their weekly verses...

- ◆ Bringing a friend
- ◆ When we ask them to only memorize a part of a verse, they recite the **entire** verse as written in the Bible
- ◆ If a child can recite the entire passage at one time as seen above, he or she will earn an extra \$10 Club Cash at the store night in December!
