The dates listed are when they learn the verse. They recite them the following Wednesday.

- Jan. 6** **Psalm 147:4-5a** He counts the stars and calls them all by name. How great is our Lord! His power is absolute!
- Jan. 13** **2 Corinthians 4:18a** So we don't look at the troubles we can see now; rather, we fix our gaze on things that cannot be seen.
- Jan. 20** **Genesis 1:1** In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth.
- Jan. 27** **Hebrews 13:8** Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, today, and forever.
- Feb. 3** **Store and Gym Night**

- March 10** **Psalm 23:1** The Lord is my shepherd; I have all that I need.
- March 17** **Psalm 107:9** For he satisfies the thirsty and fills the hungry with good things.

- March 31** **Psalm 29:2** Honor the Lord for the glory of his name. Worship the Lord in the splendor of his holiness.
- April 7** **Psalm 139:14a** I praise you, for I am fearfully and wonderfully made. ESV
- April 14** **Mark 10:45** For even the Son of Man came not to be served but to serve others and to give his life as a ransom for many."
- April 21** **Colossians 4:2** Devote yourselves to prayer with an alert mind and a thankful heart.
