

Revised Face Mask Policy

(September 2020)

On May 24 when we reopened for on-sight worship service we required face masks to be worn in public spaces until seated in the sanctuary or other room. The following is our revised face mask policy that will start on September 6.

We recommend that face masks be worn in public spaces until you are seated in a socially spaced location in the sanctuary or other room. We ask everyone to refrain from congregating in narrow & high traffic areas inside. We encourage you to fellowship & congregate outside after services when possible and in the gym & other large rooms (Fellowship Hall & Adult Learning Center) when the weather does not allow this.

All pastoral staff, on duty deacons, greeters, security team and ushers serving the congregation will be required to wear face masks while they are serving people in public areas.

If you are sick or have a compromised immune system, please consider attending our on-line service rather than our on-sight ministries.

Other Things to be Considered

- You are welcome to wear a face mask all the time in any worship service.
- We also have an on-site live-stream option with face masking available in the ALC at 8:15am.
- If you prefer a less crowded service, we suggest you attend the 8:15am or 9:30am worship service.
- On September 13 we will be re-starting the 9:30am Traditional Service for a 4-week trial (we will have back rows reserved in this service for those who want to wear a face mask the entire service with no one singing behind them).
